HOW TO EASILY ENSURE THAT YOUR MAC WILL RUN WELL FOR A LONG TIME

There are 3 things that every Mac OS X user should know and use in order to keep there Mac running smooth.

1. Repair Permissions
2. Onyx
3. Single User Mode and `/sbin/fsck -fy`

KEYBOARD MAKING UTILITIES

If you would like to make your own keyboard, then *Ukelele* is the utility that will help you to do this quite easily. The only suggestion I have when using *Ukelele* is:

1. put a copy of the keyboard I sent out with Donkey 3.0, *UyghurArabickeyboard.layout*, somewhere other than the *Home/Library/Keyboard layouts* folder.
2. when making a new keyboard in *Ukelele*, under the *File* menu choose *New Based*

On... , and do not choose *New*.

3. In the popup window, locate the copy of the *UyghurArabickeyboard.layout* file that you put somewhere on your computer, and base the new keyboard on that.
4. Follow the *Ukelele* hlep for how to use the program
